2017 Barolo Castiglione

£180 c/s IB – 3 cases available (6 bts per case)

The 2017 Barolo Castiglione is a wild, exotic wine. Super-ripe red cherry, kirsch, cinnamon, tobacco, new leather and rose petal all flesh out in this ample, voluptuous Barolo from Vietti. The 2017 is a wine of significant heft hidden behind a wall of tannin. Give it a few years to soften or open it well in advance. Time brings out striking translucence as well as finesse.

2017 Barolo Lazzarito

£340 c/s IB – 10 cases available (3 bts per case)

£260 per Magnum IB – 2 Magnums available (OWC/1)

Vietti's 2017 Barolo Lazzarito is absolutely gorgeous. Whatever the challenges of the growing season, they appear to have been no problem here. More than anything else, the Lazzarito impresses with its magnificent depth and stature. Super-ripe red fruit, white pepper, mint, tobacco, cured meat, spice and rose petal open gradually with time in the glass. I would not

be in a rush to open bottles anytime soon. The Lazzarito has been one of the most improved wines at Vietti for a number of years. The 2017 is so captivating.

2017 Barolo Brunate

£375 c/s IB – 2 cases available (3 bts per case)

£270 per Magnum IB – 2 Magnums available (OWC/1)

The 2017 Barolo Brunate is a powerful, brooding wine. Huge dark fruit, leather, spice, menthol and dried herbs all build in a potent Barolo that is enshrouded by tannins. The 2017 is going to need quite a bit of time in the cellar. Today, it is very much a brooding powerhouse. Dark wild cherry, licorice, tar, menthol and spice take shape in the glass, but

the 2017 is clearly an infant, and an unruly one at that.

2017 Barolo Rocche di Castiglione

£390 c/s IB – 3 cases available (3 bts per case)

£275 per Magnum IB – 1 Magnum available (OWC/1)

£595 per Double Magnum (3L) IB – 1 available (OWC/1)

The 2017 Barolo Rocche di Castiglione shows all the signatures of this site, all turned up to the maximum. I am not sure I have ever tasted a Vietti Castiglione with this much heft.

Super-ripe dark red fruit, rose petal, mocha, dried herbs and menthol all build in an ample,

resonant Barolo. Readers should be prepared to cellar the 2017 for the next handful of years, perhaps longer. A whole range of floral and savory notes punctuates the explosive finish.

2017 Barolo Ravera

£340 c/s IB – 9 cases available (3 bts per case)

£260 per Magnum IB – 2 Magnums available (OWC/1)

£575 per Double Magnum (3L) IB – 1 available (OWC/1)

The 2017 Barolo Ravera is a powerhouse. My impression is that the 2017 is going to develop into something truly special. It has all the energy that makes this site so distinctive, but with an extra kick of fruit density and a whole range of exotic aromatics that make for a truly drop dead gorgeous wine. Bright red/purplish fruit, rose petal, chalk and white pepper build into a finish laced with searing intensity. This is such and impressive wine.

2017 Langhe Nebbiolo Perbacco

£99 c/s IB – 3 cases available (6 bts per case)

The 2017 Langhe Nebbiolo Perbacco is silky, perfumed and pretty. Sweet floral notes, mint, chalk and sweet red berry fruit are all laced together in this very pretty, inviting wine. Pliant and racy, the Perbacco is a terrific introduction to the Vietti wines.

A wine with a diehard fan club, the Vietti 2017 Langhe Nebbiolo Perbacco drinks like a young Barolo but costs a fraction of the price. I really need to say little more because that accurately sums up the vast appeal of this classic and versatile Nebbiolo. The bouquet is expressive and fresh with wild berries, blue flowers, spice and tobacco. Besides a bit more color concentration that you might notice in the wine's appearance, Perbacco magically shows no sign of the hot vintage.

2017 Barbaresco Masseria

£400 c/s IB – 3 cases available (6 bts per case)

£135 per Magnum IB – 3 Magnums available (OWC/1)

The grapes are harvested from vineyard located Treiso and Neive. The vineyard has a southern exposure with a mix of clay and limestone in the soil.

Garnet ruby colour, slight garnet hue, with intense aromas of ripe cherries with intricate complexities of minerals, tea leaves and rose petals. With firm, ripe tannins, crisp acidity and feminine and round structure, this Barbaresco shows incredible finesse with excellent balance, integration and a long, lingering finish.
